 - B. She understood from the message death to life. Rom. 6:3-5
 - C. No longer the same but a new person spiritually.
- 3. She Shared her home with her new family. V.15
 - A. She stated if you believe my conversion.
 - B. She said abide stay with my family.
 - C. She knew they were new to the area.
- 4. She served as a comforting believer and supporter. V 40
 - A. She had to be interested about their life.
 - B. She receives the brethren and comforts them.
 - C. She leaves off the scene making an impact in their life.

Application for us today.

- 1. Prayer can change the course and cause the word to be received in unusual ways and places. V. 9
- 2. People you would think that would not receive the word are searching for it and don't even know it.
- 3. Because someone was concerned about this city, Lydia was able to hear the glorious gospel.
- 4. Having church is not confined to a building, it's where a servant's heart is ready to share a life-changing word.
- 5. Prayer moved the Heart of God, and it caused worship and praise. V.13&25
- 6. When one is saved, they are then part of the work of God.
