- 1. How humble and valuable he considered the gospel. V.7&8
 - A. He considers it an honor.
 - B. The operation of God power working in him.
 - C. The riches the gospel offers everyone.
- 2. How that the wisdom of God can be conveyed to the church. V. 9&10
 - A. To show all people the fellowship offered.
 - B. To show it would be personal to each one.
 - C. That Jesus Christ was the foundation for the church.
- 3. How that the gospel is eternally life changing. V11&12
 - A. His boldness in faith toward Christ.
 - B. His confidence is that he has access always.
 - C. That living out his faith was life changing to others. V. 13

Application for us today.

- 1. The purpose of the gospel is to change lives.
- 2. The humble servant is the servant who makes the impact.
- 3. God can't use pride, only those with passion for Him. James 4:6&7
- 4. Remembering who we are and where we have come from.
- 5. This will motivate us to be like Paul.
- 6. He was the least of the apostles to share the gospel.
- 7. It's only when we surrender to the inner man Eph.4:16&17
- 8. Then we can be the humble servant God can use.
